



dam grew up in a blue-collar family. "We weren't wealthy by any means," he says. "I grew up in the trailer park, graduated high school and joined the Army."

Adam did a deployment in Bosnia, but his career ended because of an injury received stateside. "I had a lot of issues after I got out and I fell in with some people who were doing meth."

When everyone around him was going to jail, Adam decided to clean up his act. For a time, he was a transport driver traveling around the country delivering cars and commercial vehicles. "I ended up having to quit because my oldest son's mom abandoned him and he went to live with my parents, so I had to stay local to help take care of him."

When the police found someone else's drugs in Adam's car during a routine stop, he was given probation, but he violated it by driving out of state, which landed him in jail. "After getting released, I basically had nowhere to go."

"Now, I'm in the Training Faithful Men Program, and I'm playing catch up.
